## Approval of Expenditure by Conservation Department

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C., 1300k et seq.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized, subject to the veto of the Tribal Ogema, under Article IV, Section 7(i)(1) of the Constitution to approve expenditures of Tribal funds, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted the <u>Budget and Appropriations Ordinance</u>, #01-100-04, which identifies and authorizes expenditure of funds within an approved budget through regulations created by the Tribal Ogema and adopted by the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Purchasing and Procurement Regulations, #R100-01:AC-01, have been approved by the Tribal Ogema and Tribal Council which directs that authorization of expenditures in excess of \$10,000 must be made by the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the <u>Conservation</u> Department has budgeted <u>\$110,000</u> for the purpose of entering into program related activities: and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received a request for approval of the above expenditure;
- NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves the expenditure of budgeted funds in the amount of \$40,322.20 as identified.
