Approving Budget Modification to the Fiscal Year 2002 Operating Budget for the Tribal Government and Appropriating \$76,000.00 from the U.S. v Michigan "Fisheries Trust" Fund to the General Fund to be Allocated to Start-Up Costs for the Commercial Fishing Program in the Conservation Department

WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k <u>et seq</u>.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and

- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, 7(i)(2) of the Constitution, has the power to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tribe and to appropriate such funds for the benefit of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Conservation Department requested an appropriation of \$76,000.00 as part of its Fiscal Year 2002 budget proposal to support the acquisition of equipment necessary to implementation of commercial fishing operations by members of the Tribe in calendar year 2002; and
- WHEREAS, the amount requested for the Department's Great Lakes Fisheries Assessment program was not included as part of the Fiscal Year 2002 Operating Budget; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has established a Fisheries Trust with funding received from the State of Michigan and United States under the terms of the Consent Decree settling the Great Lakes fisheries portion of the <u>United States</u> v <u>Michigan</u> treaty rights litigation; and

- WHEREAS, the terms of that Consent Decree are intended to facilitate the Tribe's to use settlement funds to assist Tribal members enter the commercial fishery in waters near the Tribe's Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has previously authorized execution of an agreement to lease a trap net vessel for use by Tribal members participating in the Commercial Fishing Educational, Training and Development Program and the acquisition of additional equipment is needed to undertake additional fishing operations; and
- WHEREAS, the itemized budget supporting this appropriation request by was prepared by participants in the Commercial Fishing Educational, Training and Development Program with the assistance of the consultant retained to work with those members; and
- WHEREAS, acquisition of required equipment and supplies required to prepare the leased vessel for fishing activities will require an appropriation of up to \$76,000.00 from the <u>U.S.</u> v. <u>Michigan</u> Fisheries Trust; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe's Natural Resource Commission has reviewed the attached budget and appropriation request and supports the request for funds and appropriation from the <u>U.S.</u> v <u>Michigan</u> Fisheries Trust Fund; and
- WHEREAS, an appropriation of up to \$76,000.00 from the <u>U.S.</u> v <u>Michigan</u> Fisheries Trust will require a modification of the Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2002, which was approved on December 19, 2001.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves a modification of to the Operating Budget for the Tribal Government for Fiscal Year 2002 to include an appropriation of \$76,000.00 from the <u>U.S.</u> v <u>Michigan</u> Fisheries Trust account, in the Trust and Agency Fund, to be allocated to the General Fund used for the purchase of equipment and supplies necessary to equip the leased trap net vessel for use by Tribally-licensed commercial fishing operations.
