## APPROVAL FOR SUBMISSION OF THE LITTLE RIVER BAND OF OTTAWA INDIANS INDIRECT COST PROPOSAL FOR FY 2003

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has developed a proposal for Indirect Cost for the Tribe for Fiscal Year 2003, and
- WHEREAS, The United States Department of the Interior has been designated to be the cognizant agency for the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians to negotiate our Indirect Cost Proposal

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council by this resolution authorizes the submission of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Indirect Cost Proposal for FY 2003 to the Office of Inspector General United States Department of the Interior.
