BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP GRANT

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and


WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians operates a Law Enforcement Department and is concerned for the safety of our Law Enforcement Officers, and


WHEREAS, The Bureau of Justice Assistance has funding to pay for up to 50% of the costs of Bulletproof Vests for our Law Enforcement Officers through the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Program

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that by this resolution the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council authorizes the submission of a grant to the Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$2,621.50 for a Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant.
