Approving Budget Modification to the Program Budget in the Natural Resource to Include a Supplemental Appropriation from the U.S. v Michigan Fisheries Trust Fund in the Amount of \$30,000.00 for Vessel Dockage/Storage Fees for the Trap Net/Gill Net Vessels Received from the State of Michigan

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, 7(i)(2) of the Constitution, has the power to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tribe and to appropriate such funds for the benefit of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Conservation Department requested an appropriation of \$30,000.00 to be added to its Fiscal Year 2002 budget proposal to cover expenses associated the docking and storage of the trap net and gill net vessels the Tribe is receiving from the State of Michigan under the terms of the Consent Decree settling the Great Lakes fisheries portion of the <u>United States</u> v <u>Michigan</u> treaty rights litigation (the "Consent Decree"); and
- WHEREAS, the amount requested for the expenses for dockage and storage of the commercial fishing vessels was not included as part of the Fiscal Year 2002 Operating Budget; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has established a Fisheries Trust with funding received from the State of Michigan and United States under the terms of the Consent Decree; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.10(d)(3) of the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance, Ordinance #01-100-04, requires any change in the scope of a program budget to be approved by both the Tribal Ogema and Tribal Council.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves a modification of to the Program Budget for the Natural Resources Conservation Department's Fiscal Year 2002 Program Budget to include a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$30,000.00 from the U.S. v Michigan Fisheries Settlement Fund for expenses associated with dockage and storage of the four (4) commercial fishing vessels the Tribe is receiving from the State under the terms of the Consent Decree.
