Support of Application for Variance for Placement of Water Tower

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has approved and authorized the site selection for the Aki Maadzi Win project; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has approved and authorized the site selection for the Little River Casino Resort permanent facilities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that development of a water and wastewater system is an appropriate government function to supprt the Aki Maadzi Win project, the Little River Casino Resort Project, and other future development activities in that area; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has identified, and the Tribe has purchased, property which is an appropriate location for the placement of a water tower to support water system; and
- WHEREAS, as a result of the location of the Manistee-Blacker Airport, an application was submitted and the Federal Aviation Administration has approved the application identifying the height of the water tower and flight path clearances; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema has authorized submission of a zoning variance application to Manistee Township in regards to the water tower placement which is 30 feet above the maximum zoned height restrictions for that property; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves of the placement of the water tower at that location which maximizes water pressure for the water system;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby supports the presentation of an application for a zoning variance to Manistee Township by the Tribal Ogema.
