Constitutional Amendments - Recall of Tribal Court Judges and Appellate Judges

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article XIV, Section 2, to present amendments to the Constitution to the Secretary of the Interior to hold a Secretarial Election when such amendments are adopted by resolution of the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been presented amendments which call for the ability to recall Tribal Court Judges and Appellate Judges; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and recommended clarification of the proposed amendments in work sessions held on February 7, 2002, April 11, 2002 and August 2, 2002; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that these amendments are in an appropriate format and should proceed to a Secretarial Election and that by adoption of this resolution identifies its support that such amendments should be presented; and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby requests the Secretary of the Interior to present the following amendment to the Constitution of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians to the membership for consideration in a Secretarial Election in accordance with Article XIV, Sections 1 and 2:

Article X.

Section 2 - Recall.

The registered voters of the Tribe shall have the right to recall the Tribal Ogema, of any member of the Tribal Council, or a Tribal Judge or Appellate Judge by filing a recall petition with the Election Board. The petition must be signed by at least twenty-five percent (25%) of

the registered voters of the Tribe. The Election Board shall verify and approve/deny the petition within thirty (30) days of receipt. At least fifty percent (50%) of the verified signatures on the petition must be registered voters who are eligible to vote in the election of the Tribal Council member now subject to recall.

The Election Board shall conduct a recall election within ninety (90) days of the Election Board's verification and approval of the petition and its signatures. If the term of office for the Tribal Ogema or Tribal Council member being recalled will end within six (6) months of the date the Election Board verifies and approves the recall petition the issue will be held until the next regularly scheduled session.
