COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION


- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is a member of the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan and recognizes the importance of the Community Services Block Grant funds to Indian Communities and the support it provides Tribes, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians wishes to authorize Sharon Teeple, Executive Director of the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan to apply for the Community Services Block Grant from the Office of Community Services, United States Department of Health and Human Services for Fiscal Year 2003

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution authorizes Sharon L. Teeple, Executive Director of the Inter-Tribal of Michigan to apply for funding from the Community Services Block Grant from the Office of Community Services, United States Department of Health and Human Services for Fiscal Year 2003 funding and negotiate and implement the financial award on behalf of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians as a member Tribe of the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan.


