Resolution # 02-0828-

Accepting Funds from Language Camp T-Shirt Sales and Designating Such Funds for the Special Purpose of Engaging Artist to Create Portraits of Two Tribal Elders

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(i)(1) to adopt and make amendments to the budget of the Tribe, subject to the ratification of the Tribal Ogema; and
- WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2002 Budget contained funds for hosting the 2002 Language Camp and the purchase and sale of t-shirts at that activity; and
- WHEREAS, the t-shirt sales generated approximately \$1700.00 in sales of which there has been a request to have these funds accepted into the Tribal General Fund and identified for a specific purpose; and
- WHEREAS, the use of the fund raising dollars will be to contract for portraits, to be hung in the Little River Band Community Center, of two elders who have passed on -Jonnie Sam and Doris Wabsis - who have been instrumental in assisting the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians in re-capturing its language; and
- WHEREAS, the cost of portraits and/or plaques would be fully covered by the funds generated from the t-shirt sales;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council hereby directs that the Fiscal Year 2002 budget is modified to include the program activity in program # 130, line # 5602 (supplies) for the purpose of purchasing memorial portraits and/or plaques.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby directs that the funds deposited with the Tribe in the General Fund from the 2002 Language Camp t-shirt sales in the amount of \$1,700.00 be designated

specifically for use to purchase portraits and/or plaques for Jonnie Sam and Doris Wabsis, elders who have given time and energy to re-kindling the language of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians.
