Identifying Confidential and Proprietary Documents

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS the Tribal Council may meet in closed session for the purpose of Personnel Matters, provided the employee in question did not request a public meeting, or Business matters involving consideration of bids or contracts which are privileged or confidential, or Claims by and against the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS the record of business conducted in closed session shall be maintained in a closed file in perpetuity; and
- WHEREAS the Tribal Council recognizes that all Records and attachments of Closed Sessions are subject to Confidentiality Provisions, and should be visibly marked as such; and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council hereby declares that all Confidential "records" or "proprietary information" shall be visibly stamped or marked with a text, that such documents are CONFIDENTIAL and/or PROPRIETARY; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT No records contained in Closed Session files may be disclosed by any means of communication to any person, or another agency, except pursuant to a written request by the Ogema, or with the prior written consent of the Tribal Council, or pursuant to the order of the Tribal Court upon a showing of good cause; and Resolution # 02-0916-02 Page 2 of 2

IT IS FINALLY RESOLVED THAT no confidential/proprietary Closed Session documents shall be permitted to leave the Tribal Council Chambers without prior written consent of the Tribal Council; and

It is further finally resolved that the Tribal Council Recorder shall ensure that all confidential/proprietary documents that may have been previously released to Tribal Councilors and the Ogema shall be collected.
