Approval to Enter Into Contract - Joseph Eve & Company: 401(k) Plans Years 2000-2002

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has entered into contracts to provide a 401(k) retirement plan, and does provide this employee benefit to its employees; and
- WHEREAS, the plan requires, under federal law, that annual reports be conducted; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has not received reports for the years 2000 through 2001, and anticipates requiring a 2002 report in the near future; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has entered into an engagement contract with an audit firm such that continuing with the same audit firm to complete the 401(k) audit requirements would result in a more comprehensive audit being completed with cost savings, as well as the audit firm having the requisite qualifications to conduct such an audit;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the Tribal Council Speaker to enter into the engagement letter with Joseph Eve & Company, LLP for the purposes of conducting an audit of the Tribe's 401(k) plan.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the payment of the \$2500 retainer to Joseph Eve & Company and delegates to the Tribal Council Recorder the responsibility to monitor and approve expenses related to this contract.
