Resolution No. #02-1023-

Acceptance of Grant Funds from United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and Approving a modification to the Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2002 in the amount of \$250,000

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C., 1300k et seq.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7(a) of the Constitution, has the power to provide for the general welfare of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7 (i)(2) of the Constitution, has the power to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tribe and to appropriate such funds for the benefit of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the acceptance of grant funds from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) will require a modification of the Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2002, which was approved on December 19, 2001.
- NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves a modification to the Operating Budget for the Tribal Government for Fiscal Year 2002 to include grant funds in the amount of \$250,000 from United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for expenses associated with the Brownfields Economic Development Initiative. Funds shall be allocated as follows:
