Resolution of Support for the Submission of Renewed Grant funding for the Circle of flight Project Through the Bureau of Indian Affairs, U.S. Department of the Interior

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress and Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has need to continue to improve the conditions of wetlands and the habitat of native species throughout the Tribal territories.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution accepts and supports the submission of the Circle of Flight in the amount of \$38,300 for the 2003 fiscal year.
