Approving Contract with Michigan Technological University

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7 (a) of the Constitution, has the power to provide for the general welfare of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted Resolution 02-10-16-04 accepting grant funds in the amount of \$84,374 from Great Lakes Fishery Trust for cost associated with Lake Sturgeon assessment activities; and
- WHEREAS, the Great Lakes Fisheries Trust Lake Sturgeon Assessment Grant identifies that the Tribe shall subcontract and collaborate with Michigan Technological University for services; and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the Ogema, or in the absence of the Tribal Council Speaker to execute the attached Agreement # 1 between the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians and Michigan Technological University.
