## **Resolution # 03-0129-18**

Authorization to Enter Into Memorandum of Agreement with City of Manistee, Michigan to Cooperatively Manage an EPA Brownfield Demonstration Assessment Pilot Grants

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(b) to ratify agreements between the Tribe and other governmental entities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe and the City of Manistee have received Brownfield Demonstration Assessment Pilot Grants from the EPA which is in the best interests of the Tribe and the City to cooperatively manage; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe and the City have agreed to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement to cooperatively manage the grants;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby ratifies the Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Manistee, Michigan and the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians and authorizes the Ogema to enter into the agreement.
