Authorizing Negotiation and Execution of a Fiscal Year 2003 P.L. 93-638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. '1300k et seq.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe and its members are eligible for all services and benefits provided by the federal government to Indians as members of federally recognized Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7(b) of the Constitution of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribal Constitution), has the power to authorize and ratify agreements and contracts negotiated on behalf of the Tribe with the federal government; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema, pursuant to Article VI, Section 5(a) of the Tribal Constitution, is authorized to negotiate and execute contracts on behalf of the Tribe, provided such contracts are approved and ratified by the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized to contract for federal funds under the authority of the Indian Self-Determination Act (P.L. 93-638, as amended), and to implement and administer services for its members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to enter into a FY 2003 Self-Determination Act contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs in accordance with the terms and conditions described in the model Contract and Annual Funding Agreement and the Scope of Work and Budget allocations contained in the FY 2003 Proposal presented by the Tribal Ogema.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby requests to contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to provide services under the authority of the Indian Self-Determination Act and authorizes the submission of its contract proposal to the Bureau of Indian Affairs Michigan Field Office.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Ogema, or in his absence, the Tribal Council Speaker, is authorized to negotiate and execute a Self-Determination Contract, and any amendments, and is also authorized to serve as the Tribal Senior Official Representative for purposes of the contract, including execution of any modifications to the Fiscal Year 2003 Contract and Annual Funding Agreement.
