Resolution # 03-0604-154

Approval of Additional Stipends for the Cultural Preservation Committee for a Limited Time

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(g) to create committees and delegate responsibilities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted the *Committee Procedures Policy* on April 13, 1997 which identified the structure and responsibilities of committees created by the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee was created by the Tribal Council to be responsible for culturally related activities of the Tribe, specifically the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Annual July 4th traditional pow wow; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted resolution # 02-0807-05 which clarified and set the stipend amount for committee members at \$50 per meeting and restricted the number of compensated meetings to two meetings per month; and
- WHEREAS, that resolution directs that committees may request, by resolution, the Tribal Council to approve additional meetings per month, Resolve #4, by setting forth the number of extra meetings and the reasons for those extra meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee is in the process of organizing the Annual July 4th traditional pow wow which requires significant time commitments to be made by the committee members in order to provide for proper invitations, contracts and organization of volunteers;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the members of the Cultural Preservation Committee to be paid an additional 2 stipends per month during the months of May, June and July in order to properly organize and conclude the Tribe's July 4th traditional pow wow. Such authorization shall be retroactive to extra meetings that may have been held in the month of May.
