Declaration of First Legislative Recess for 2003

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution provides that the "schedule of meetings for regular sessions of the Tribal Council for [each succeeding] calendar year shall be set by resolution of the Tribal Council at the last regular session of each calendar year" and that such schedule "shall be published and made available to the General Membership;" and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approved the meeting schedule for 2003 in resolution # 02-1218-01; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council receives three legislative recesses per year as set forth on resolution # 03-0419-100, Resolve #3 (3a); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that a legislative recess should be scheduled during the month of July;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby declares that a legislative recess is scheduled to begin on Friday, June 27, 2003 through July 6, 2003.
