## Resolution # 03-0625-190

Resolution Setting Contact and Lead Representative in Regards to Tribal Actions

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhing Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has engaged consultants and professional services firms for recent actions facing the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, many of the consultants and professional services have actions that interact with or have an impact on other projects; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that clarification of the roles and responsibilities is necessary to avoid conflict and negative impact on any of these activities;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby directs the following individuals as 'lead representatives' as set forth below. All contacts shall be through the lead representatives.
