

> TRIBAL COUNCILORS WERE ASKED TO REVIEW THE DRAFT MINUTES AND COMMENT ON THEM. IT WAS NOTED THAT SOME COUNCILORS DID NOT RECEIVE ALL OF THE DRAFT MINUTES AS OF THE MEETING.

E. PUBLIC COMMENT

MATT STRATTON DICUSSED VIDEO TAPING TRIBAL COUNCIL MEETINGS FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE MEMBERSHIP. A TEST MEETING WAS SUGGESTED. IT WAS FURTHER SUGGESTED BY LEGAL COUNSEL THAT THIS PROCESS BE GRANTED THROUGH RESOLUTION APPROVAL. ALSO A POLICY OF PROTOCAL TO DETERMINE IF WE ARE GOING TO ALLOW THESE TAPES TO THE PUBLIC, OR JUST THE MEMBERS,. A FURTHER SUGGESTION WAS RECOMMENDED THAT RELEASES WOULD NEED TO BE SIGNED, WITH DOCUMENTATION OF WHAT THE TRIBE WOULD BE CONSENTING TO. CONCERNS WERE RAISED ABOUT THE PROTECTION OF THE TAPES SO THAT THEY WOULD NOT BE REPRODUCED WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE TRIBE.

III. GRANTS & CONTRACTS BUSINESS. (JOHN BUSSEY).

A. ROADS TRAINING & PLANNING GRANT.

JOHN BUSSEY PROVIDED AN EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AND RESOLUTION TO THE TRIBAL COUNCIL. THE PROPOSED BIA GRANT WAS FOR BIA ROADS TRAINING & PLANNING GRANT AND DID NOT REQUIRE A TRIBAL MATCH. KATHY BERENTSEN NOTED THAT THE CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION ON THE RESOLUTION CONTAINED AN ERROR.

JOHN BUSSEY PRESENTED THE LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION GRANT PROPOSALTO THE TRIBAL COUNCIL. JOHN BUSSEY NOTED THAT THIS COVER PART OF THE PLANNING STAFF WAGES. THE GRANT APPLICATION IS MADE TO THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLANNING. JOHN BUSSEY SAID THAT THE GRANT APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE 16TH OF MARCH AND WOULD BE AWARDED BY SEPTEMBER. JOHN BUSSEY CLARIFIED TO COUNCILORS THAT THIS WAS NOT A SURE THING, IT WAS JUST A REQUEST FOR THE GRANT.

JOHN BUSSEY PRESENTED THE PROPOSAL THE THE TRIBAL COUNCIL, REQUEST FOR THREE YEARS. JOHN BUSSEY EXPLAINE THAT IT MAY BE APPROVED FOR THE FIRST YEAR WITH PROBABLE FUNDING FOR THE SECOND YEAR. OR FUNDED FOR ALL THREE YEARS. KATHY BERENTSEN BROUGHT UP THAT IF THE TRIGGER EVENT GOES INTO EFFECT, THE TRIBE MAY NOT HAVE THE FUNDS TO MATCH TO THIS GRANT. JANINE SAM INFORMED KATHY BERENTSEN THAT WE HAVE MONEY FOR THE LANGUAGE IN THE YEAR 2001 BUDGET. KATHY BERENTSEN NOTED THAT THAT DOES NOT COVER THE OTHER TWO YEARS. JOHN BUSSEY SAID THAT IF WE CANNOT MEET THE WATCH FOR THE GRANT, THAT WE COULD TURN BACK THE GRANT. JOAN SPALDING EXPLAINED FOR THOSE PRESENT THAT THE TRIGGER POINT HAD TO DO WITH CASINOS AGAINST GAMBLING LAWSUIT AND THAT THE TRIGGER POINT IS SOME THEORETICAL POINT IN THE FUTURE AT WHICH IT COMES TO THE SUPREME COURT.

JOAN SPALDING SAID THAT THE RESOLUTION NAMED THE TRIBE AS THE LITTLE RIVER BAND OF ODAWA INDIANS, AND THAT IS NOT WHAT WE ARE NAMED. THE INTENT WAS TO SET ASIDE THE CURRENT AREA USED FOR THE POW WOW AS THE PERMANENT PLACE FOR CULTURAL PURPOSES.

B. PURCHASE OF VEHICLE. (A.L. DEBRES). TO INCREASE FLEET TO INCREASE PATROL SERVICES.

ART DEBRES STATED THIS PURCHASE WAS PART OF A RESOURCE GRANT THAT WAS AWARDED FOR THE YEAR 2001. TAMMY KLEEMAN ASKED ART DEBRES ABOUT THE GRANT WHICH WOULD PURCHASE THE VEHICLE, AND IF THERE WAS A TRIBAL MATCH OF FUNDS FOR THE GRANT.. THERE WAS A TRIBAL MATCH OF ABOUT \$4,000. FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE PROPOSED VEHICLE. BILL BROOKS EXPLAINED THAT THE EASON THIS ITEM WAS ON THE AGENDA WAS BECAUSE OF A POLICY THAT IF AN ITEM IS OVER 2500, IT MUST COME BEFORE THE TRIBAL COUNCIL. KATHY BERENTSEN ASKED WHO WOULD BE USING THIS VEHICLE, FOR PATROL. TRANSPORTATION OF PRISONERS, CONSERVATION, WHAT WAS THE NEED FOR THIS VEHICLE. ART DEBRESSAID THIS WOULD BE FOR PATROLING. CAROL BENNETT ASKED ART DEBRES TO CLARIFY THE PAPERWORK WHICH WAS SUBMITTED TO THE COUNCIL ON THE PRICE OF THE VEHICLE, WHICH LISTED A TOTAL DELIVERED PRICE OF \$26,199.40 FOR A 2001 TAHOE. ART EXPLAINED THAT THE GRANT WAS UP TO 30,000, BUT THE TRIBE MUST PAY 25%. JANINE SAM ENLIGHTENED THE COUNCIL TO THE FACT THAT THE SCRIBBLE ON THE AGENDA REQUEST, WITH AN ARROW POINTING TO IT, WAS IN FACT THE SIGNATUE OF APPROVALFOR THIS PURCHASE BY BOB GUENTHARDT, THE OGEMA.

C. PURCHASING A SNOWMOBILE. (A.L. DEBRES). TO PURCHASE A SNOWMOBILE TO PATROL THE PROPERTY THAT WE OWN BECAUSE OF ACCESSIBILITY.

ART DEBRESS PRESENTED THE AGENDA ITEM TO THE TRIBAL COUNCIL. ART PROVIDED THE COUNCIL WITH BIDS FOR DIFFERENT SNOWMOBILES. ELAINE PORTER ASKED WHY THIS WAS BEING PURCHASED AT THIS TIME OF THE YEAR. JANINE ASKED WHY WE WOULD BE PURCHASING A 1998 VEHICLE, AND IF THERE WAS DOCUMENTATION THAT THE VEHICLE WAS IIN GOOD CONDITION BASED ON THE MILEAGE OF THE MACHINE. ART DEBRES SAID THAT THIS OLDER MODEL WAS ACTUALLY A BETTER MODEL TO NOT OVER HEAT. IT WAS NOTED THAT THE MILEAGE OF THE SNOWMOBILE WAS NOT LISTED ON THE PAPERWORK PROVIDED. JANINE SAM ASKED IF THERE WAS A DISCLOSURE FROM THE PRIVATE INDIVIDUAL THAT KNOW ONE IN ADMINISTRATION IS AFFILIATED WITH THIS PERSON.

JANINE SAM FURTHER STATED THAT SHE WANTED TO ENSURE THAT THIS WAS NOT JUST A FRIEND WHERE TRIBAL FUNDS WERE GOING TO BE USED TO PURCHASE THE VEHICLE. KATHY BERENTSEN STATED THAT SHE BELIEVED A NEW SNOWMOBILE COULD BE PURCHASED FOR THIS PRICE WITH WARRANTY. CONNIE WAITNER STATED THAT SHE WAS ALSO CONCERNED ABOUT PURCHASING USED, THAT WE MAY BE INHERITING SOMEOONE ELSES PROBLEMS. CONNIE WAITNER FURTHER SAID THAT SHE UNDERSTOODTHE PURCHASE WAS NECESSARY FOR ALL THE LAND WE HAVE, BUT THAT WE SHOULD BE ABLE TO SHOP AROUND AND FIND SOMETHING NEW.ELAINE PORTER SUGGESTED THAT THE ITEM BE PURCHASED EARLY IN THE FALL. JOAN SPALDING ASKED WHO LOOKED AT DIFFERENT SNOMOBILES. ART SAID THAT HE SUBMITTED THREE BIDS AND ALSO HAD TWO OTHERS. ART WAS ASKED IF HE HAD ANY RESPONSE TO THE STAEMENTS OF COUNCILORS...ART DEBRES STATED THAT IF THE COUNCIL WAS WILLING TO BUDGET MORE , HE HAD NO OBJECTIONS TO BUYING NEW., ALSO THAT THE AMOUNT BUDGETED FOR A SNOWMOBILE HAD BEEN SOMEWHAT CONSERVATIVELY LOW.

> JOAN SPALDING ASKED BILL BROOOKS IF HE WOULD SPEAK ON THIS ITEM. BILL BROOKS DISCUSSED WHAT NIGA WAS, WHAT THEY ARE ACTIVE IN, AND THE MEMBERSHIP TO NIGA. BILL BROOKS SAID THAT THE RESOLUTION PRESENTED DESIGNATED THE OGEMA, COUNCIL SPEAKER, AND COUNCIL

RECORDER AS THE TRIBES' MEMBERS. KATHY BERENTSEN ASKED WHEN THAT DECISION CHANGED, BECAUSE SHE BELIEVED THAT JANINE SAM AND CHUCK FISHER HAD BEEN INTERESTED. CAROL ASKED WHO HAD SUGGESTED THE CHANGE. LISA MCCATTY ASKED JANINE SAM AND CHUCK FISHER IF THEY DESIRED TO BE THE NIGA REPRESENTATIVES. TAMMY KLEEMAN ASKED WHY THE YEARLY MEMBERSHIP DUE HAD GONE UP SINCE THE LAST TIME IT HAD BEEN ON THE TRIBAL COUNCILS AGENDA. JANINE SAM SAID THAT THE DUES AARE BASED ON THE REVENUE OF THE TRIBES CASINO, AND THAT IS WHY THE AMOUNT HAS GONE UP.

E. RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING INTERIM AUTHORITY FOR APPOINTMENT OF ALTERNATES TO THE ELECTION BOARD. (OGEMA).

THE REQUEST WAS SUBMITTED BY THE OGEMA, BOB GUENTHARDT. THE TRIBAL COUNCIL DISCUSSED THAT THERE WERE TWO DIFFERENT RESOLUTIONS FOR THIS ITEM. PAGE TWO CONTAINED CHANGES ORR QUALIFICATIONS TO BE AN ALTERNATE. JOAN SPALDING STATED THAT THIS RESOLUTION WOULD ESTABLISH A MEANS FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF ALTERNATES TO THE ELECTION BOARD. IT WAS NOTED THAT ONE OF THE ELECTION BOARD MEMBERS HAD EXCUSED THEMSELVES BECAUSE OF THE INVOLVEMNET OF A SISTER IN THE ELECTION. LISA MCCATTY ASKED WHY BOB GUENTHARDT DID NOT JUST REPLACE THE ELECTION BOARD MEMBER THAT HAD A CONFLICT. JOAN SPALDING SAID THAT AT ANY POINT ANY ONE OF THE MEMBERS COULD HAVE A CONFLICT, LISA MCCATTY ASKED WHY THE RESOLUTION STATED THAT A PERSON COULD NOT BE A BOARD MEMBER IF THEY WERE AN EMPLOYEE OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL, AND WHY WAS THAT ANY DIFFERENT THEN EMPLOYEES OF THE GOVERNMENT, BILL BROOKS SIAD THAT THEY DIFFERENCE WAS THAT THE EMPLOYEES OF COUNCIL, EMPLOYEES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS, ARE MOE CLOSELY INVOLVED IN THE AFFAIRS OF GOVERNMENT.

LISA MCCATTY MADE A MOTION TO AMEND THE RESOLUTION; UNDER THE QUALIFICATIONS OF AN ELECTION BOARD ALTERNATE; SECTION 1B, END THE SENTENCE AFTER "THE TRIBAL COUNCIL", AND STRIKE OUT "OR EMPLOYEED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL"; UNDER C, AFTER "IS NOT A MEMBER OF THE TRIBAL COURT". NO SUPPORT WAS OFFERED.

PAT RUITER ADVISED THE TRIBAL COUNCIL THAT ONLY THREE ELECTION BOARD MEMBERS HAD TO BE PRESENT TO VOTE,
THEREFORE TWO COULD BE ABSENT AND THEY WOULD STILL

HAVE A QUORUM.

THIS ITEM WAS SUBMITTED BY THE OGEMA, BOB GUENTHARDT. JANINE SAM STATED THAT SHE DID NOT HAVE A LETTER FROM THE OGEMA NOMINATING MR. ROSS, NOR DID SHE HAVE A STATEMENT FROM THE THE INDIVIDUAL DISCLOSING IF HE IS RELATED TO ANY OF THE CANDIDATES. JOAN SPALDING SAID THAT THE TRIBAL COUNCIL HAD JUST ADOPTED A RESOLUTION WHICH OUTLINED THE QUALIFIATIOIONS TO BE AN ALTERNATE. JANINE SAM REPLIED THAT YES THOSE WERE THE QUALIFICATIONS, BUT THAT IT DID NOT LIST WHAT WOULD EXCLUDE AN INDIVIDUAL FROM BEING A MEMBER; BUT THAT IT DID PRECLUDE AN INDIVIDUAL IF THEY HAD AN IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER RUNNING FOR OFFICE. JANINE SAM FURTHER STATED THAT SHE DID NOT HAVE ANY DOCUMENTATION ABOUT THE CANDIDATE TO ANSWER THESE QUESTIONS FOR CERTAIN. KATHY BERENTSEN ASKED A PROCEDURAL QUESTION ACCORDING TO THE PROCEDURES ORDINACE; SHE QUESTIONEDWETHER BILL BROOKS COULD BE PRESENTING THIS ITEM AS HE WAS NOT THE OGEMA, NOR A TRIBAL MEMBER.

MOTION TO APPOINT JOHN ROSS AS AN ALTERNATE TO THE TRIBAL ELECTION BOARD; BY CONNIE WAITNER, SUPPORT BY ELAINE PORTER.

THE TRIBAL OGEMA PLACED THIS ITEM ON THE AGENDA TO PAY AN INDIVIDUAL FOR ATTENDANCE AT A MEETING PRIOR TO APPOINTMENT. JANINE SAM SAID THAT SHE WAS NOT IN FAVOR OF PROVIDING STIPENDS TO AN INDIVIDUAL TO SERVE IN A CAPACITY THAT DIDN'T EXIST UNTIL WE JUST CREATED IT. JANINE SAM FURTHER STAED THAT SHE FELT THIS ITEM WAS IWTHIN THE OGEMAS AUTHORITY TO PAY OR NOT PAY THIS PERSON FOR ATTENDING., AND THAT THE TRIBAL COUNCIL DID NOT NEED TO APPROVE THIS ITEM. BILL BROOKS SAID THAT SINCE TRIBAL COUNCIL MEMBERS ARE PRIMARILY THE CHECK SIGNERS, THAT THE OGEMA WANTED TO BRING THIS TO THE COUNCIL SO THAT IT WAS NOT DENIED FOR A SIGNATURE. KATHY BERENTSEN SAID THAT IN THE PAST SHE HAS DENIED TO SIGN CHECKS FOR MR. ROSS AS AN ELECTION BOARD MEMBER, AND THAT SHE WAS CONCERNED ABOUT THE LINES OF COMMUNICATION BECAUSE IF IT HAD NOT BEEN FOR A TRIBAL COUNCIL MEMBER BEING THERE TO SIGN THE CHECK, IT WOULD NOT HAVE BEEN REALIZED, AND HE WOULD HAVE BEN PAID ALL ALONG WITHOUT THE PROPER POLICIES IN PLACE. JANINE SAM SUGGESTED THAT THE TRIBAL COUNCIL NOT TAKE ANY ACTION ON THIS ITEM. JOAN SPALDING REMINDED THE TRIBAL COUNCIL THAT AT THE TIME THE OGEMA SUBMITTED ELECTION BOARD MEMBER NOMINATIONS, HE ALSO NOMINATED JOHN ROOSS AS AN ALTERNATE, AND THAT THE TRIBAL COUNCIL STALLED ON APPROVING THAT BECAUSE OF THE LACK OF PROVISIONS FOR THIS IN THE CONSTITUTION, AND ALSO BECAUSE THE TRIBAL COUNCIL WAS REVIEWING THE ELECTION ORDINANCE. LISA MCCATTY STATED THAT THE TRIBAL COUNCIL HAD DENIED THE NOMINATION OF AN ALTERNATE, AND THAT THE OGEMA MUST NOT HAVE BEEN INFORMEDOF THAT ACTION, BUT BECAUSE COUNCIL DENIED APPOINTMENT OF ALTERNATES THEREFORE THERE WAS NO PROVISIONS. TAMMY KLEEMAN SAID THAT SHE HAD NOTHING TO LET HER KNOW IF JOHN ROSS WAS RELATED TO ANY OF THE CANDIDATES, BUT THAT THERE WERE 33 CANDIDATES RUNNING FOR THE COUNCIL. JANINE SAM ASKED IF SHE COULD READ A LETTER THAT SHE WAS DRAFTING FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE COUNCIL TO REFER THAT MATTER BACK TO THE OGEMA. THE COUNCIL DID NOT TAKE ACTION TO APPROVE OR DENY MILEAGE FOR MR. ROSS AS YOU HAVE IN THE PAST PAID MILEAGE AND RELATED EXPENSES FOR ELDER TO PARTICIPATE IN FUNCTIONS OF THE STATE COUNCIL BELIEVES THAT YOUR DECISIONS REGARDING THIS SPECIFIC MATTER WOULD NOT REQUIRE A SUBSIQUINT ACTION BY COUNCIL. WE FURTHER ECOMMEND THAT YOUR OFFICE DEVELOP GUIDELINE FOR THE PAYMENT OF MILEAGE AND EXPENSES ON BEHALF OF TRIBAL ELDERS AND/OR ANYONE ELSE SERVING IN CAPACITY OF THE TRIBE.

MOTION TO REFER THIS MATTER TO THE TRIBAL OGEMA WITH THE LETTER THAT WAS JUST READINTO THE RECORD, AND THAT COUNCIL NOT TAKE ACTION ON THIS AGENDA ITEM; BY JANINE SAM, SUPPORT BY TAMMY KLEEMAN.
