## Resolution 03-0730-230

Ratification of Temporary Occupancy Permits/Agreements for Four (4) Elder Housing
Units at Aki Maadiziwin, Authorizing the Tribal Ogema
to Execute Addenda to those Agreements, and Authorizing the Tribal Ogema to Execute
Temporary Occupancy Permit/Agreements with Other
Elders Qualifying for Elder Housing Units

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7(d), is authorized to approve the lease of Little River Band land or interests in land; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7(b), is authorized to ratify or authorize execution of agreements negotiated by the Tribal Ogema on behalf of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema, pursuant to Article V, Section 5(a)(3), is authorized to execute agreements on behalf of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe's Housing Commission has developed twelve (12) Elder Housing units on Tribal trust lands at Aki Maadiziwin to be leased to qualified Tribal Elders; and

WHEREAS, in order to meet the needs of Tribal Elders for housing, qualified Tribal Elders have been permitted to occupy those units under a Temporary Occupancy Permit/Agreement for Tribal Lands; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to continue to permit new and existing residents to occupy the housing units pending approval of a final lease document by the Housing Commission and Tribal Council which meets all legal requirements.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians ratifies the four (4) Temporary Occupancy Permits/Agreements executed by the existing residents of the Aki Maadiziwin housing units: Delano Peters, Howard Ramsey, Daniel Mejia and Margaret Scott.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Ogema to execute such additional Temporary Occupancy Permits/Agreements, including Addenda to the four (4) existing Temporary Occupancy Permits/Agreements, as may be necessary to permit qualified Tribal Elders to occupy the Aki Maadiziwin housing units through December 31, 2003, or until such time as a permanent lease document is approved and executed by Elders occupying these housing units.
