Resolution # 03-0806-239

Authorization to Post and Hire a General Counsel Pursuant to Resolution # 03-0423-105

WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Aníshinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted Resolution # 03-0423-105 which was intended to maintain the status quo in the Tribe's current structure until it could be reviewed and modified by the human resource consultants engaged by the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema is authorized to requested exceptions to the restrictions in Resolution # 03-0423-105 in order to manage the activities of the Tribe in implementing and running programs and services; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema had identified that the position of General Counsel is required in order to assist the Ogema in managing the affairs of the executive office and related departments; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema has identified that it is necessary to post and fill this position with a qualified individual in order to maintain and increase the level of services and activities provided by the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema has determined that re-organization of the legal staff to allow for supervision by the appropriate governmental body in relation to the expected work product is necessary in order to be able to obtain the necessary legal advice and services in a timely manner;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the posting of the General Counsel job description and hiring an individual to fill that position in accordance with the Tribe's hiring processes.

CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION

I do hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was duly presented and adopted by the Tribal Council with 8 FOR, 1 AGAINST, 0 ABSTAINING, and 0 ABSENT, at a Regular Session of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council held on August 6, 2003, at the Little River Band's Community Center in Manistee, Michigan, with a quorum being present for such vote.
