## Resolution # 03-0813-253

Appointing Representatives to the National Indian Gaming Association

- WHEREAS, the status of the Gaá Chíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) With the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, Which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted resolution # 03-0215-48 which identified that the Tribe met the qualifications to become a member of the National Indian Gaming
- Association (NIGA), authorized payment of dues, and appointed Jonnie J. Sam, II as representatives, and Janine M. Sam and Carol Bennett as alternates; and WHEREAS, the members of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians have elected four
- members to the Tribal Council and a new Ogema in the 2003 General Elections;
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that re-appointing the delegate and
- NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby appoints the following persons as Representative and instructor than to fulfill their reconneithilities as Official Alternate Representatives(s), and instructs them to fulfil their responsibilities as Official Delegates and that such designation shall continue for so long as the delegated shall have office as Ogema or members of Tribal Council.
