Resolution # 03-1001-312

Completion of Community Wellbeing and Support Implementation Requirements

- WHEREAS, the status of the Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted amendments to the Membership Assistance Program Ordinance to create a Community Support Program; and
- WHEREAS, the Membership Assistance Department was directed in resolution # 03-0917-303 to present final program regulations by September 29, identify program deadlines, and identify the departments to be contacted to develop the Community Wellbeing and Support Survey; and
- WHEREAS, the regulations have been submitted for approval in a separate resolution and have been approved by the Ogema; and
- WHEREAS, the Membership Assistance Department is presenting this resolution, with approval of the Ogema, for adoption of the time lines for the 2003 program implementation and to identify the departments that have assisted in development of the survey;
