## Resolution # 03-1008-337

Rescinding Resolution # 03-0910-280

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted resolution # 03-0910-280 which authorized the submission of a grant application to the Great Lakes Fishery Trust in the amount of \$100,420 to fund a stream side rearing facility for lake sturgeon in the Manistee River; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received additional information regarding this grant; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that it is no longer appropriate to submit the grant application and desires to rescind the earlier authorization;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby rescinds resolution # 03-0910-280 and directs that this resolution be forwarded to the Ogema in a timely manner.
