Resolution of support for submission of Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations for FY 2004

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, there is a continuing need to support the efforts of low-income Tribal families to obtain nutritional foods, and
- WHEREAS, the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations is a program administered by the U.S. Department of Agriculture Food and Consumer Service dedicated to assisting needy tribal families with nutritional foods made available through agricultural market surpluses, and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians wishes to continue this program for eligible Tribal families in need.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution wishes to request continuation funding from the U.S. Department of Agriculture for fiscal year 2004 in the amount of \$45,857.
