Resolution # 03-1105-366

Authorization to Post and Hire a GAP Coordinator Pursuant to Resolution #03-0423-105

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhing Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted Resolution # 03-0423-105 which was intended to maintain the status quo in the Tribe's current structure until it could be reviewed and modified by the human resource consultants engaged by the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema is authorized to requested exceptions to the restrictions in Resolution # 03-0423-105 in order to manage the activities of the Tribe in implementing and running programs and services; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema had identified that the position of GAP Coordinator is required in order to maintain an adequate level of service; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema has identified that it is necessary to post and fill this position with a qualified individual in order to maintain and increase the level of services and activities provided by the Tribe;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the posting of a GAP Coordinator position job description and hiring an individual to fill this position in accordance with the Tribes hiring processes.
