Resolution # 03-1105-375

Ratification of Employment Contract with Attorney Jo Anne House to Provide General Counsel Services and Authorization for the Speaker to Sign Such Contract

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council engaged Attorney Jo Anne House to provide legislative services under a three year contract approved by resolution # 00-0724-11 and as recently engaged under resolution # 03-1015-348; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has negotiated with Attorney House for appointment to General Counsel position and agreed to language amending the prior contract approved by resolution # 03-1015-348 which sets forth supervisor responsibilities over the Legislative Legal Department budget, employees and activities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been presented a contract for the purposes of engaging Attorney Jo Anne House as an employee of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians to provide General Counsel services as set forth in the contract; and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby ratifies the employment contract with Attorney Jo Anne House and authorizes the Speaker to enter into the contract.
