## **Resolution # 03-1203-410**

Ratification of Contract with Continental Linen Service and Authorization of Ogema to Enter Into the Contract

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized, under Article IV, Section 7(b) to authorize and ratify contracts entered into by the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Purchasing Manager has reviewed the expenditures of the Tribe for the current and prior fiscal years to identify purchasing activities which could be better managed through a 'master contract' with a single vendor; and
- WHEREAS, the Purchasing Manager has identified that the Tribe purchase and/or utilizes floor mat services in all of its Tribal buildings and/or offices; and
- WHEREAS, the Purchasing Manager received authorization to send out an RFP to vendors that provide this service, which was responded to by Continental Linen Services, Royal Linen Service, Inc., and our current vendor, Cintas; and

- WHEREAS, the Purchasing Manager has selected a responsive bid, Continental Linen Services, which will result in the same quality services at a lower cost; and
- WHEREAS, the Master Agreement has been reviewed by the Legal Department as well as the requested additions by the vendor; and
- WHEREAS, the Ogema has approved the selection of Continental Linen Services and has forwarded the contract for ratification by the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the materials presented by the Ogema had has determined that it is an appropriate action to ratify the contract;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby ratifies the contract with Continental Linen Services, including the addendum of the three paragraphs in the vendor's Service & Rental Agreement entitled 'Payment/Charge Terms: Net 30 Days From Invoice Date;' 'Existing Agreements;' and 'Product Liability.'

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Ogema to enter into the Master Agreement with Continental Linen Services, including the Addendum, and directs that this resolution shall be presented to the vendor with the signed contract.
