Correcting the FY2004 Budget Regarding Family Services Department to Accurately Identify Existing Employees

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted the FY2004 Budget, Resolution # 03-1217-424, which identified the funding, narrative actions, and employees in each department; and
- WHEREAS, the Family Services Budget mis-identifies existing employees in regards to the job titles which has been brought to the attention of the Ogema; and
- WHEREAS, the Ogema, upon review of the budget, current employees, job descriptions, and Personnel Action Forms, has determined that the budget should be corrected with a budget modification; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been presented the budget, job descriptions, and Personnel Action Forms which identifies the existing employees and has determined that correction of the FY2004 Budget is an appropriate process;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby amends the FY2004 Budget, for the Family Services Department, to make the following employment title changes.
