Authorization of Payment of \$ 5,000.00 to Miller, Johnson, Snell & Cummiskey for the Purpose of Submitting a Qualified Plan Anonymous Submission to the Internal Revenue Service

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhing Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(i)(2) to manage funds within the control of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed of the Tribal Government 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan failures necessitating the fee for the anonymous submittal in the amount of \$5,000.00 to correct said failures; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed by the Comptroller General that it is appropriate pay the fee required for the submittal; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the request and submitted information and has determined that it is an appropriate action to authorize this payment;
