## Resolution # 04-0421-165

Authorization of Expenditures from the Public Information Office Budget

- WHEREAS, the status of the Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is required under Article IV, Section 7(i)(1) to approve the budget for the Tribe for each fiscal year, which occurred by adoption of resolution # 03-1217-424; and
- WHEREAS, the Ogema is required to ratify the Tribal Council's approval of the budget under Article V, Section 5(c) which occurred on December 23, 2003; and
- WHEREAS, resolution # 03-1217-424 restricted use of specific program budgets, in this case the Public Information Office, until authorized by resolution of the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Ogema has submitted -

job descriptions for the Public Information Director and Public Information Specialists,

- Standard Operating Procedures for Media Contact and Newspaper Production; and
- a proposed organizational chart which includes the new positions and department;

WHEREAS, the Ogema has also identified office space and equipment for the proposed new descriptions;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the use of the Public Information Office budget, Program # 1000-152, and lifts the restriction set in Resolution # 03-1217-424.
