## Resolution # 04-0512-194

## Budget appropriations for Utilities Department

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhing Ziíbi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted November 7, 2001 Utility Ordinance # 01-500-05 Section 5.01 General. The utility shall be given the powers set forth in this section to allow it to carry out its duties and functions; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted November 7, 2001 Utility Ordinance # 01-500-05 Section 5.02. Contracting; Agreements. The authority to enter into agreements, contracts, and understandings with any governmental agency, federal state, or local or with any person, partnership, or corporation, shall be subject to the laws and regulations of the tribe regarding such approval and authority; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted November 7, 2001 Utility Ordinance # 01-500-05 Section 5.05 Employ personnel. The water and waste water director, in accordance with the employment ordinances, regulations and policies of the tribe, shall employ personnel to operate the community water and sewerage systems, to establish the duties and compensation of employees, and to pay this compensation as an operating expense of the community water and sewerage systems.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the tribal council approves budget appropriations in the amount of \$34,381.00; \$13,000.00 in recovery of expended line items (5301 & 5600) \$11,400.00 in wages \$5771.00 for travel \$4,210.00 for lodging.
