## Resolution # 04-0616-252

Supplemental Appropriations for Legal Department Budget - Professional Fees - Compact Issues Follow-Up

- WHEREAS, the status of the Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted the FY2004 Budget by resolution # 03-1217-424; and
- WHEREAS, the Legal Department had identified sufficient funding for the Fiscal Year which has been affected by legal matters facing the Tribe in the six months and resulted in a need to identify supplemental funding; and
- WHEREAS, the General Counsel Legislative has identified areas in need of supplemental funding involving Professional Fees;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves the following supplemental appropriation in the total amount of \$50,000.00 which shall be allocated as follows, and approves the related budget narratives for those supplemental appropriations.

\$50,000 \$30,000 - New Contract - Kanji & Katzen - Compact Issues Legal Opinion Follow-up, potential related litigation matters

\$20,000 - New Contract - Drummond Woodsum & MacMahon - Compact Issues Legal Opinion Follow-up, potential related litigation matters
