## Resolution # 04-0630-285

Establishing the Final Budget for the Complete Little River Casino and Resort Expansion

Project

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has approved the Little River Casino and Resort *Expansion*Project which consists of additional hotel rooms, entertainment venue and sports bar;
  and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has approved the creation of the Development Committee by resolution # 04-0310-115 and delegated certain responsibilities and authorities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has approved the Architect Contract with Hnedak Bobo Group, Inc., which identifies estimated project costs in schedule 1.1.2.2; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that the entire project, including financing and other estimated project costs should be identified in a Final Budget for the project in order to more clearly identify the scope and cost of the Expansion Project; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been presented with a Final Budget estimate from the Transition Oversight Committee and the Chief Financial Officer which identifies the related costs to the Expansion Project;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves the *Little River Casino and Resort Expansion Project Final Budget* as follows.
