## **Resolution # 04-0825-348**

Approval of Budget Modification Amending the Elders Assistance budget, Program #1000-105 and Transferring Funds to the Tribal Ogema budget, Program #1000-102 in the amount of \$288,900

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7 (i)(2) of the Constitution, has the power to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tribe and to appropriate such funds for the benefit of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Ogema has presented a budget modification which transfers budgeted funds from the Elders Assistance budget to the Tribal Ogema budget to cover costs associated with contractual obligations; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the budget modification and has determined that this action requires the Tribal Council and Ogema approval in accordance with the Constitution and section 5.10(d) of the <u>Budget and Appropriation Ordinance</u>, #02-100-04.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves the budget modification moving funds from the Elders Assistance budget, Program #1000-105, Acct. #5208 in the amount of \$288,900.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council authorizes these funds to be transferred to the Tribal Ogema budget, Program #1000-102, Account # 5205 – Professional Fees, providing that the funds may not be reallocated to any other line item within the Ogema's budget, and may be used only for the purpose represented, to pay the contractual obligations indicated.
