## Resolution # 04-0915-375

Authorizing Execution of Casino Careers Online Service Agreement for Job Posting

- WHEREAS, the status of the Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(I) to take action, not inconsistent with the Constitution or Federal law, which is necessary and proper to carry out the sovereign powers of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, pursuant to Gaming Commission Ordinance No. 02-400-04, created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Triba and to enforce all Tribal and federal laws governing the conduct of Tribally-licensed gaming activities; and
- WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission, pursuant to Section 6.01 of Gaming Commission Ordinance, is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations as may be necessary to interpret and implement the Gaming Ordinance and to establish regulatory systems to effectuate the powers granted by ordinances of the tribe and other duties imposed by applicable law; and

- WHEREAS, the Little River Band Gaming Commission is, pursuant to Section 6.09 of the Gaming Commission Ordinance (Ordinance #02-400-04), may employ staff as may be required to fulfill the Gaming Commission's responsibilities.
- WHEREAS, the Surveillance Supervisor position has been posted within the Tribe and in area newspapers with no qualified candidates resulting.
- WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission determined that entering a 1 month 1 posting contract with Casino Careers Online will allow the position to be advertised at a broader range which will result in more candidates applying.
- WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission has presented this agreement to the Tribal Council for authorization.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby executes an engagement letter retaining Casino Careers Online for posting of the Surveillance Supervisor position for one month.
