Approval of Budget Modification Amending the Tribal Historic Preservation Budget, Program #1000-154, and Transferring Funds to Various Budgets as Identified in the Attachment to Fund COLA and Merit Increases

- WHEREAS, the status of the Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Ogema has presented a budget modification which transfers budgeted funds from the Tribal Historic Preservation budget to the various budgets to provide funding for the payment of COLA September 2004 increases and Merit Increases to Tribal Government Employees as outlined in the Attachments; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the budget modification and has determined that this action requires the Tribal Council and Ogema approval in accordance with the Constitution and section 5.10(d) of the <u>Budget and Appropriation</u> Ordinance, #02-100-04.
