## **Resolution # 04-1020-417**

Ratification of Contract with Nichol Stout, and Authorization of the Ogema to Enter Into the Independent Contractor Agreement

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized, under Article IV, Section 7(b) to authorize and ratify contracts entered into by the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, this agreement is made by and between Nichol Stout, hereafter referred to as the "Contractor", and the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (the "Tribe") whose address is 375 River Street, Manistee, MI 49660, as of October <u>10</u>, 2004 (The "Effective Date").

WHEREAS, The Contractor shall provide professional consulting services related to the Tribe's obligations under a U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service funded project to evaluate habitat restoration in the Manistee River Corridor in accordance with the scope of work.

WHEREAS, the Independent Contractor Agreement has been reviewed by the Legal Department; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the materials presented by the Ogema had has determined that it is an appropriate action to ratify the contract;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby ratifies the Independent Contractor Agreement with Nichol Stout,

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Ogema to enter into the Independent Contractor Agreement with Nichol Stout
