## III. OLD BUSINESS

A. AUTHORIZE DISBURSEMENT OF PER CAPITA FUNDS TO MINORS REACHING THE AGE OF 18 DURING THE MONTH OF MARCH. 80/20 Plan and Ordinance No 98-200-04 requires Council approval of disbursement of funds held in trust for minors. The following persons turned 18 in March and have requested disbursement of their funds: Timothy James Marks, Keith Allan Sam, James Elsie Dixon, Jr. and Stephanie Lynn Soto.

B. EASTLAKE PROPERTY – ENVIRONMENTAL REPORT. To provide Council and Tribal Administration a better understanding of the environmental issues related to tenancy on the Eastlake property, the Planning Dept. respectfully submits information and presents Westshore Consulting to answer questions.

C. REVIEW PROPOSED EDUCATION COMMISSION ORDINANCE AND GET COMMENTS FROM EDUCATION COMMITTEE MEMBERS. (FOR INFORMATION ONLY) A draft of this Ordinance was passed out to Council members and Education Committee members a couple of weeks ago. Want to get this Ordinance on track for review/discussion/revision for consideration for enactment at earliest possible date.

D. APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION REQUESTING TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT OF BIA LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO THE TRIBE'S RESERVATION. This item was on last meeting's agenda but no action taken because of a lack of response from BIA. BIA – U.S. Attorney's representatives discussed need for law enforcement presence in Manistee to address law enforcement on Tribal lands pending Tribe's establishment of its Public Safety Department. I spoke with Jeff Davis from the U.S. Attorney's Office recently and he suggested acting on Resolution to "push" BIA on this issue.

Resolution 99-0411-02 w/roll call record: 9 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstentions and 0 absent.

## IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. ADDITION OF MEMBERS TO THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE. The Committee is asking that Council approve to allow five members from within the four-county service area instead of three as stated in the Committee Compliance Plan. If approved, the Committee recommends appointing Sally Jobes and Kim Alexander. There will be only one stipend request (5 people) per month with rotating stipends so everyone has a chance to receive one. The Committee is also asking for a staff liaison.

Motion to approve w/roll call record: 5 in favor, 4 opposed. Motion to reconsider resulted in approval w/roll call record: 7 in favor, 2 opposed, 0 abstentions and 0 absent.

B. HEALTH APPEALS BOARD. Now that the clinic is open, medical appeals are expected. The Appeals Board is to consist of three people that the Committee has agreed upon. For the Council's information only, those people are Sally Jobes, Joan Spalding and Bill Memberto.

Presented for information only. It was suggested that alternates be considered for this Board and also that x1 meeting per month be established. No action on the part of the Tribal Council regarding this matter was required.

C. SOLICITATION OF BIDS FOR SIGNS FOR TRIBAL BUILDINGS. The Health and Human Services Committee would like a sign for the health clinic so people can identify the building easier. It has also bee mentioned that signs are needed for our other buildings. The HHS Committee is an advisory committee and therefore, cannot solicit bids to bring to Council for approval. The Committee is asking Council to give the Committee the authority to solicit bids, make a recommendation and bring it back tot he Council for approval.

Motion that HHS work with Bob Guenthardt regarding signage was passed with roll call record of 9 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstentions and 0 absent.

D. APPROVAL OF ATTORNEY FEES/EXPENSES FOR ZIONTZ, CHESTNUT, ET AL FOR JANUARY/FEBRUARY 1999. This statement represents fees for work by Marc Slonim relating to Great Lakes fishing issues. Fees billed total \$8,103.00 and expenses \$1,430.78. Marc reduced the fees by \$1,500.00. These fees and expenses will be paid for from the Request for Appropriated Attorney Fees funded for FY 1998.

Motion to approve w/roll call record of 8 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 abstentions and 0 absent.

E. APPROVAL OF ATTORNEY FEES/EXPENSES FOR CALCUTT, CUNNINGHAM ET AL FOR DECEMBER 1998. This statement represents the balance of fees for work in negotiating provider contracts for clinic. Fees total \$570.00 and expenses \$43.80. There was money programmed under Clinic operations for FY 1998.
