Resolution # 04-1103-440

Ratification of Contract with Dixon Engineering Co., for Water Tower Construction Inspection Services and Authorization of a Limited Waiver of Sovereign Immunity

- WHEREAS, the status of the Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has created a Utility Department with responsibilities to manage the Tribe's water and waster water utilities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has identified the need to improve the Tribe's water utilities by construction of a water tower; and
- WHEREAS, the contract to construct the water tower has been ratified and inspection services are needed to verify the quality of the work product;
- NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby ratifies the contract with Dixon Engineering Co., to provide inspection services in the construction of a water tower.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council, in accordance with Article XI of the Constitution, and in accordance with the Arbitration Ordinance, does hereby authorize a limited waiver of sovereign immunity for the purpose of committee or compelling binding arbitration as identified in the Addendum to the Contract.
