**Resolution # 04-1110-454**

*Approval of a grant application to the Environmental Protection Agency under the Brownfield Clean-Up Grant Program for the East Lake Property in the amount of \$200,000 for Fiscal Year 2005*

WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Aníshinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and

WHEREAS, based on previous environmental assessments, there is known to exist contaminants on the Manistee Drop Forge site, otherwise known as the East Lake property; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe is dedicated to promoting community revitalization by addressing potential health risks on Tribal lands in a manner that will restore economic vitality to areas where brownfields exist.

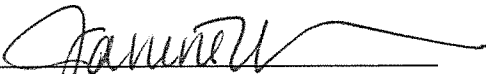
WHEREAS, the proposed grant program will fund clean-up costs up to \$200,000 per site, subject to an approved clean-up plan.

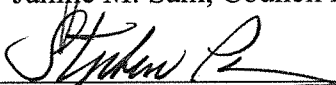
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution approve the submission of a grant application to the Environmental Protection Agency under the Brownfield Clean-Up Grant Program for the East Lake Property in the amount of \$200,000 for Fiscal Year 2005.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians commits to a Cash Match in the amount of \$40,000 to support the project costs and to comply with the matching requirements of the grant program.
