Approving Modification to Facilities Department Budget Narrative for Fiscal Year 2005 and Authorizing Amendment to FY2005 Operating Budget to reflect adjustments to training and travel line items

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(i)(1) to approve the annual budget presented by the Tribal Ogema; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council received the final Fiscal Year 2005 Tribal Government Operations Budget from the Tribal Ogema on November 15, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted Resolution #04-1215-510 approving the FY2005 Tribal Government Operations Budget, which included certain restrictions on specific expense categories within the Facilities Department, Program #2000-400; and

WHEREAS, the Facilities Director is requesting approval a modification to the Facilities Department for Fiscal Year 2005 that will release any restrictions on specific line items, and provide narrative to support the expenditures as budgeted.

NOW IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council hereby approves a modification to the Facilities Department Budget Narrative for Fiscal Year 2005 as follows:

Small Equipment & Furniture #5601

Fabricate and wire new office for Facilities Director. Upgrade lawn equipment, new office for maintenance office personnel. Replacement/ Repair of furniture and windows in tribal buildings. Purchase of small maintenance equipment (i.e. chain saws/ ladders). To cover all fixtures for overall facilities (i.e. plumbing fixtures) signage and storage cabinets for maintenance manuals.

Plan to send 4 maintenance techs to 3 schools:

1. Hands-on electrical troubleshooting I & II - (2 day class in Kalamazoo)
