Approval of Enrollment Commission's adoption of an amendment to its by-laws modifying the number of Commissioners necessary to establish a quorum from 4 to 3

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article II, Section 4 to establish ordinances governing membership; and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Commission was created by the Tribal Council through adoption of the Enrollment Ordinance and delegated responsibility to manage the membership roll of the Tribe (#04-200-01, Article VI); and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Ordinance provides that all other rules of procedure for the conduct of meetings shall be determined in accordance with any applicable Tribal Ordinances or policies governing the conduct of meetings (#04-200-01, §6.02); and

- WHEREAS, the <u>Commissions Ordinance</u> directs the Commission to identify in its bylaws the number of commissioners required for a quorum to conduct meetings (04-150-01, §6.02(d)); and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Commission set forth, in its resolution #EC 08-08-2005-A, adopted on August 8, 2005, its reasoning for modifying the number of commissioners required to establish a quorum as follows:
- WHEREAS, since February of 2005, the Commission has functioned with two less than the number of Commissioners provided by law; of the three vacancies occurring in this time frame, only one has been filled. To date, there remains two unfilled Commission appointments; and
- WHEREAS, the Commission fears that the number of commissioners available for establishing a quorum may not be met due to possible conflicting outside commitments and pending treatments for illness that certain commissioners will have to address; and
- WHEREAS, this inability to establish a quorum will adversely affect the ability of the Commission to fulfill its lawful duties and result in unnecessary delay in completing the enrollment file review mandated by law

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council approves the adopted modification to the Enrollment Commission's by-laws as set forth in its resolution #EC 08-08-2005-A, amending § 4.04 of its by-laws to establish that it shall have three (3) members present, one being an officer, to make a quorum at meetings.
