Resolution # 05-0831-419

*Approving the Renewal of Tribal Government Property Insurance Coverage with
Lexington Insurance Company Effective September 1, 2005*

WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Aníshinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7 (i)(2) of the Constitution, has the power to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tribe and to appropriate such funds for the benefit of the Tribe and its members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Government Property insurance coverage will expire on September 1, 2005; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended to renew the Property insurance coverage with Lexington Insurance Company effective September 1, 2005.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves the renewal of Property insurance coverage with Lexington Insurance Company effective September 1, 2005.


NOW THEREFORE IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council ratifies the policy contract with Lexington Insurance Company for Property Insurance and authorizes the Ogema to enter into the contract.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council, in ratifying this contract does not explicitly nor impliedly waive the sovereign immunity of the Tribe and nothing within these contracts or policies shall be construed or interpreted to be a waiver of the Tribe's sovereign immunity.

CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION
