## **Resolution** # 05-1005-484

Approving Budget Modification for Public Safety 2002 Tribal Resource Grant, Program #4205-000 in the amount of \$2,737.00

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council amended the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance, #01-100-04, through the passage of Resolution #05-0817-391, which eliminates the Tribal Ogema's authority to approve line item budget modifications under Section 6.03; and
- WHEREAS, the Public Safety Department 2002 Tribal Resource Grant Program #4205-000 has requested a line item budget modification in the amount of 2,737.00, the required expenditures to be purchased under this grant has been met and the Department of Justice has approved to move the remaining amount to purchase a laptop computer and accessories; and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians in accordance with the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance,
