## **Resolution # 05-1102-560**

Interim Emergency Disaster Relief Act of 2005 - Amendment to Include Victims of Further Hurricanes for the 2005 Season

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhing Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has identified a gap in the provision of services to persons affected by disasters, especially where federal, state and local programs are unable to meet the immediate needs of those persons, including basic food, clothing, shelter, and health care needs; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has identified that as a result of long term federal policies, and personal economic needs of individuals, that members live throughout the United States, and the world; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has identified that members, regardless of where they reside, in times of disaster, should be able to rely upon their government, the Little River Band of Ottawa, as they have historically relied upon each other, to provide assistance in times of natural disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted Resolution # 05-0914-459, which was intended to provide relief to victims of Hurricane Katrina, and has subsequently identified the need to provide relief to those affected by Hurricane Rita which hit near the Texas and Louisiana borders, affecting additional members;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted Resolution # 05-1005-498, which was intended to provide relief to victims of the following storm, Hurricane Rita, and has subsequently identified the need to provide relief to those affected by Hurricane Wilma which hit the state of Florida, affecting additional members;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to identify that any and all final hurricanes in the 2005 Hurricane Season shall be incorporated into this program;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby amends the *Interim Emergency Disaster Relief Act of 2005* and makes assistance available to those members affected by all remaining Hurricanes in the 2005 Hurricane Season.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT it is the intention of the Tribal Council that this program provide direct funding to these members without delay. The Members Assistance Program is encourage to take all efforts to contact persons living in the area devastated by hurricanes in order to determine whether Relief Funds are needed.
