## **Resolution # 05-1130-634**

Acceptance of Locums Tenes provider contractor Staff Care as per Tribal Council Resolution #05-0727-342

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7 (i)(2) of the Constitution, has the power to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tribe and to appropriate such funds for the benefit of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the acceptance of the locums tenens provider contract will allow for the continued provision of patient care with minimal interruption during those times the primary physician is allowed time off per current contact language, and;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves the contract with Staff Care, Inc., a contractor with the government services division, federal supply contract #v7971-4209a, the action to contract requested per Tribal Council Resolution # 05-0727-342, with the costs to be \$98.00 per hour/40 hours per week, \$3,920.00 MINIMUM upon the assignment of a locums provider as per the contract language. Additional funds, if necessary, shall be requested should there not be sufficient funds in the current budget to cover the costs of the service if requested prior to the end of FY 2005, Program #4104 — Clinic and Community Health Services.
