A discussion ensued regarding the Forest Festival. Questions were raised of where the float is being stored, was \$31,000 donated for the Forest Festival, and where did the 1st place monies from the float go? Tribal Council will investigate and report back.

The question was raised whether the policies for public safety were done. Tribal Council will investigate and report back.

Discussion arose regarding if all financing documents for the permanent casino were read. Parsons stated that all documents were read and three people were in the room at all times while in Minneapolis.

The subject of casino bonuses arose and this will be handled in a Tribal Council work session next Tuesday.

Don Koon queried why there were changes to the Business Board membership and regarding salary of the Business Board members. It was stated that the Business Board does not get paid.

A question was raised whether it is true that employees at the casino over 2 years get 23 PTO days? It was stated that casino employees do not get 23 days of PTO until 4 to 5 years of service.
