## **Resolution # 08-1015-345**

Rescinding Resolution #08-0123-21 and Approval to Post Amendments to the <u>Budget and Appropriations Ordinance</u>

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaa Ching Ziibi Daawaa Anishinaabek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7 (a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, in consultation with the Ogema, determined that amendments to the <u>Budget and Appropriations Ordinance</u> were required which would allow the Tribal Ogema to approve budget modifications within 10% of a program's total original budget; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council adopted emergency amendments to the <u>Budget and Appropriations Ordinance</u> by Resolution #08-0123-21; and
- WHEREAS, the emergency amendments to the <u>Budget and Appropriations Ordinance</u> were never permanently adopted; and

- WHEREAS, the emergency amendments to the <u>Budget and Appropriations Ordinance</u> have expired and are no longer in effect; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council believes that it is in the Tribe's best interests and in furtherance of the Ogema's orderly administration of Tribal Departments to approve posting of the amendments to the <u>Budget and Appropriations Ordinance</u> and rescind Resolution #08-0123-21, which have expired.
- NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby rescinds Resolution #08-0123-21 Emergency Adoption of Amendments to the <u>Budget and Appropriations Ordinance</u>.
- IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves posting of the amendments to the <u>Budget and Appropriations Ordinance</u> as attached, which allow the Tribal Ogema to approve budget modifications within 10% of a program's total original budget without Tribal Council approval.
- IT IS FINALLY RESOLVED THAT the amendments shall not be effective until expiration of the thirty (30) day posting period and upon permanent adoption by Tribal Council Resolution.
